

SPRING/FALL LEAF/YARD WASTE PROGRAM -BASED ON YOUR RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Spring: Begins Tuesday, May 30, 2023 - (B- Week) and Ends Tuesday, July 25, 2023 - (B-Week)- Completed
Fall: Begins Monday, October 16, 2023 - (B- Week) and Ends Friday, December 22, 2023 - (A-Week) - Weather Permitting

- Residents are required to put leaves/grass clippings in paper bags ONLY, NO PLASTIC BAGS, or they can be put in garbage cans clearly marked Yard Waste.
- Brush/Branches will be tied in bundles, not in barrels or bags, of no more than four (4) feet in length and four (4) inches in diameter.
